

# Halley Drive Reconstruction

## Village of Malone, New York

In 1984, the Village of Malone conducted a survey to determine the extent of neighborhood deficiencies in the Academy Street neighborhood. Over 75% of local residents thought that streets and sidewalks were the biggest problems, followed by curbs, and streetlights. The worst street was Halley Drive, a gravel and dirt road with undersized water and sewer line. The Village received a \$750,000 Comprehensive Small Cities Community Development Block Grant in 1984 to fix this road, run a housing rehabilitation program, and provide daycare subsidies to low income residents.



### Activities

- 1,000 linear feet of 8" Sewer line
- 1,000 linear feet of 6" Water line
- 1,000 linear feet of 24" Storm line (steep grade)
- 1,000' x 30' Road Reconstruction
